PENROSE SCHOOL Grant Funding 2017-18

Pupil Premium Grant (PPG)

The Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) is additional government funding given to schools in order to enhance the progress, attainment and wellbeing of disadvantaged pupils. It is currently given to pupils in receipt of free school meals, children looked after by the Local Authority and the children of service personnel.

In 2017-18 Penrose School was allocated £27,120 the following charts demonstrate what we anticipate the funding will be spent on and the impact it will have to disadvantaged children.

Penrose school has 48% of pupils on roll eligible for Pupil Premium funding.

How the Governing Body holds school leaders to account for the spending of the Pupil Premium Grant.

The Executive Headteacher reports annually on how the Pupil Premium Grant has been spent in the previous year and the impact that it has had on pupil progress and well-being. It also reports on what it intends to spend the current year Pupil premium Grant on in order to enhance the progress and well-being in the next year.

Penrose School Pupil Premium Provision Mapping 2017-18

The pupil premium is additional monies given to schools to support pupils who are considered disadvantaged. The chosen measure for this is the entitlement of Free School Meals within the past 6 years, service children and those who are in Care.
The current funding is approximately £27,120 in total. Estimated costs have been allocated in the following way.

Interventions: 1:2:1 interventions to support attainment in core subjects

Overview: Pupils to be offered additional 1:1 time for reading practice and supporting inclusion within a mainstream setting.

Cost £5259

Aim/outcomes: To increase rates of progress for pupils in their reading. The most able pupils to have a greater level of challenge, from working within a mainstream classroom.

Interventions: To provide specialist communication provision across all sites

Overview: To provide a specialist TA to support communication development for all pupils to ensure all pupils can access learning.

Cost £ 4084

Aims/outcomes: To increase rates of progress of pupils to increase the number of students who meet or exceed their individual targets.

Interventions: Uniform Provision

Overview: School Uniform provided for those in most need

Cost: £ 250

Aim/Outcomes: To promote a sense of well-being and belonging to the school community through quality uniform provision

Interventions: Nurture breakfast

Overview: To provide nurture breakfast for all pupils

Cost: £500

Aim/Outcomes: To improve readiness and engagement in learning.

Interventions: Family & Wellbeing Team

Overview: To continue to provide support to families, including holiday support and a focus on attendance.

Cost £8106

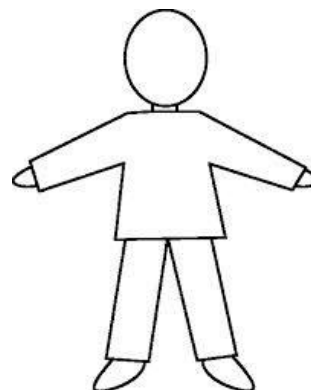
Aim/Outcomes: To improve the engagement with families and increase participation at school meetings and events.

Enrichment & off-site activities

Overview: Curriculum enrichment and off-site learning activities subsidised to ensure access for all pupils

Cost: £1601

Aim/Outcomes: Raise aspiration, motivation and engagement. Give practical application of learning in the classroom & to support enrichment weeks.



Supporting the whole child

Interventions: Malachi Family support

Overview: To continue to provide support to families, including holiday support and a focus on attendance.

Cost £3000

Aim/Outcomes: To support families with their own difficulties to overcome barriers for their children's learning and aspirations.

Extra-Curricular after school Clubs Overview:

Monies available to support children in their choice of after school clubs.

Cost £4320

Aims/outcomes: To increase the number of students who participate in after school clubs – to engage students in active, physical and/or creative arts through extra-curricular activities.

GREEN – Academic focus

BLUE – Enrichment/ Engagement focus

YELLOW – Well-being focus

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
